APPROACHING HURRICANE ADVISORY

Attention Town Resident / Property Owner / Business Operator:

Based on information from State and County officials that a Tropical Storm / Hurricane is rapidly approaching the South Florida area. Please note the following:

Surfside Town Hall will be closed, effective 2 PM on Wednesday, October 5, 2016 until Monday, October 10, 2016.

The beach will be closed and there will be no lifeguards after 2 PM on Wednesday, October 5, 2016 through Friday, October 7, 2016, with possible reopen dates of October 8 and 9th, to be determined.

The Parks and Recreation facilities will also be closed, effective from 2 PM on Wednesday, October 5, 2016 through Friday, October 7, 2016, with possible reopen dates of October 8 and 9th, to be determined. The facilities to be closed include the following:

- Community Center and Pool
- 93rd Street Lifeguard Tower
- 96th Street Park
- Hawthorne Tot Lot
- Tennis Center

There will be no garbage or recycling pick-up on Thursday, October 6th. Solid waste collection is tentative (to be determined) for Friday, October 7, 2016.

For your protection and that of your neighbors, we ask you to prepare for the approaching storm by doing the following:

- **Dispose of household and yard trash items before the storm threatens.**
- **Collect and store away all lawn furniture, barbecues, garbage and recycling containers, and other outdoor items that are not tied down and could become airborne.**

- **Secure all boats and trailers.**
- **Secure all construction sites. Tie down and/or store away all items that could become airborne during high winds.**
- **Do not begin any tree pruning or cleanup activities or place trash on the curb for pickup once a Tropical Storm or Hurricane Watch or Warning is issued.**
- **If you are living in a beachfront property, please secure all patio furniture, and remove all beach chair furniture from the public beach.**
- **If you operate a Sidewalk Café business s, then please store all tables, chairs, umbrellas, planters and other furniture items inside of your restaurant as the storm approaches.**
- **For power outages, contact Florida Power and Light at 305-442-8770.**
