SeeClickFix is a mobile phone app for reporting non-emergency conditions within Surfside that may need to be addressed by the Town. (For emergencies call 911.) Download this free app or visit our website [www.townofsurfsidefl.gov](http://www.townofsurfsidefl.gov).

SeeClickFix is geo-dynamic, which means it knows where you are reporting from and directs the information to the right department. It allows you to use descriptions, photos and videos to instantly report situations that require attention and follow-up. Through the app, you can also communicate, comment, get updates and thank those who worked to solve the issue.

## PUBLIC WORKS

### Hazardous Waste Drop-Off at Town Hall on May 20

Residents are encouraged to bring hazardous waste products to the Public Works Department on Saturday, May 20, 2017 from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. Hazardous materials will be collected on this day **ONLY** and residents must follow these guidelines:

- All materials must be sealed tightly and properly to avoid any spills
- All material that is loose (i.e. batteries) must be bagged.
- All bio-hazardous waste/medical waste (sharps) must be secured and shall be placed into the sharps container by the resident disposing it.

Public Works staff reserves the right to refuse residents



if the guidelines are not followed. Public works staff will assist but will not handle any incoming materials.

**These will be accepted:** anti-freeze, household chemicals or fertilizers, propane tanks, paint and paint thinner, household pesticides, batteries, pool chemicals and used motor oil.

**These items will not be accepted:** mercury thermostats/thermometers or devices/items containing mercury, medicine/pharmaceutical waste (note that a prescription drug take-back event is scheduled on Saturday April 29 at Haulover Park. See page 3)

- 5.) Applicant must demonstrate a positive-impact through community/civic involvement as determined through letters of recommendation and responses included in the application.


