

## **3v3** Basketball Tournament Rules

# 1. **Team Composition**

- Each team consists of **3 players on the court** with up to **2 substitutes**.
- o Teams must have at least **2 players** to start a game.

#### 2. Game Duration

- o Games are to **21 points** (win by 2) or a **20-minute running clock** (whichever comes first).
- o If the time expires, the team with the most points win.

## 3. **Scoring**

- o **1 point** per basket inside the arc.
- o **2 points** for shots made beyond the 3-point line.

## 4. Possession & Checking

- The ball must be "checked" (passed) at the top of the key before each possession.
- o The offensive team must pass once before shooting.
- o After a **basket is made**, the defense gets possession.

#### 5. Timeouts

- Each team will be granted a 45-second timeout.
- This timeout does not stop the game clock.
- o No timeouts are permitted in the last three minutes of the game.

## 6. Shot Clock & Stalling

- o A 15 second shot clock.
- o Holding the ball excessively may result in a turnover.

## 7. Fouls & Free Throws

- No individual foul limit, but 6 team fouls result in bonus (1 free throw per foul and possession of the ball).
- $\circ$  Shooting fouls inside the arc = 1 free throw, beyond the arc = 2 free throws.
- o Non-shooting fouls reset to a check at the top.
- o Flagrant or unsportsmanlike fouls may result in technical fouls.
  - Two technical fouls result in ejection.

### 8. **Ball Clearance**

- On rebounds or turnovers, the ball must be cleared beyond the 3-point line before shooting.
- o If a team fails to clear the ball properly, the basket doesn't count, and the possession changes.

#### 9. Overtime

o If tied, the first team scored **2 points** in overtime wins.

#### 10. **Substitutions**

o Allowed **only during dead balls** (after fouls, out-of-bounds, or timeouts).

## 11. Sportsmanship

- o No fighting, taunting, or disrespectful behavior.
- Officials may issue warnings, technical fouls, or disqualifications for violations.
