Officer Arch Celebrates 25 Years



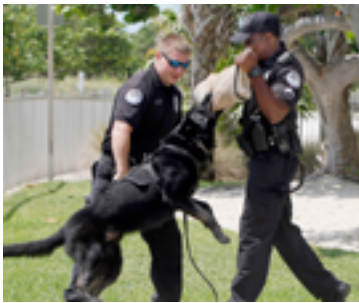
Officer Loxley Arch recently celebrated his 25th anniversary with the Town of Surfside Police Department. A luncheon in his honor was held on July 6.
