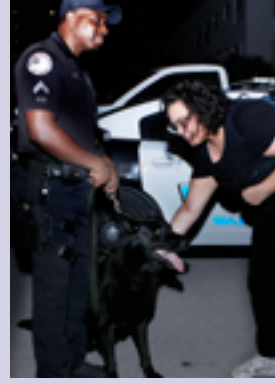


## POLICE BEAT
