

Tennis Center “New Normal” Guidelines

In an effort to enhance social distancing practices the facility usage will be limited to:

- Courts will be open to Surfside Residents only
- Singles/Doubles Play Only
- No clinics, private lessons, and/or programming allowed
- Court Reservations only accepted – NO WALK-INS (Free of Charge)
- Court Reservations to occur via phone at least one day prior to court time or via online at townofsurfside.skedda.com/booking
- Tennis Center phone number **(786) 618 - 3080**
- Only Surfside Residents will be allowed to reserve the court
- Proof of residency needs to be shown at time of court RSVP (Bank Statement, Utility Bill, Driver’s License, or Surfside ID is accepted)
- Bookings to occur between the hours of 8:00AM - 8:00PM
- Check-in process - little to no interaction between the front desk and the players

We ask for your assistance and adherence to the following policies and procedures:

- Use of Facial Coverings is required when entering and exiting the courts
- Facial Coverings only to be removed once on the court before play
- Facial Coverings to be put back on upon exiting courts
- Tennis players to furnish their own balls for play
- Clean and wipe down your equipment
- No sharing
- Bring water bottles as water fountains and coolers will not be available
- Use new balls and grips if possible
- Consider wearing gloves
- Arrive as close as possible to time of play
- Avoid touching gates, fences, etc. if you can
- There will be no selling of drinks

When Playing

- Try to stay 6 feet apart
- Use Four or Six Balls
- Open 2 cans of tennis balls that do not share numbers
- Player 1 gets one set of numbers and Player 2 gets another
- Players to pick up their number only
- Avoid incidental contact
- Avoid touching face after handling ball, racquet and equipment
- Avoid sharing food, drinks or towels
- Stay on your side of the court
- Avoid changing end of the court
- Use your racquet/foot to pick up balls and hit them to your opponent or other courts.

After Playing

- Leave the court as soon as possible
- Use hand sanitizer coming off the court
- All players should leave the court immediately

Restroom

- Restrooms will remain closed

As the Parks and Recreation Department begins moving forward with the “new normal” at the Surfside Tennis Center, we ask you to assist in abiding and helping us enforce updated rules and regulations.
