

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-2537.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2018 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2019; ANNOUNCING THE PERCENTAGE DECREASE IN THE ADOPTED FINAL MILLAGE RATE BELOW THE ROLLED BACK RATE COMPUTED PURSUANT TO STATE LAW; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser (“Property Appraiser”) has certified the taxable value within the Town of Surfside (the “Town”) for the year 2018 which includes all real property within the Town; and

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2018, the Town Commission held its first budget public hearing and adopted Resolution No. 2018- 2535 setting the tentative millage rate at 4.5000 mills for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2018;


WHEREAS, the Town Commission finds that it is necessary to levy and adopt a final ad valorem millage rate in the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission and the Town Manager have reviewed the Town’s proposed Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Budget, considered an estimate of the necessary expenditures contemplated in the Budget, and have determined that the final millage rate levy set forth below provides the necessary funds for such budgetary expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That the above-stated recitals are hereby adopted and confirmed.

Section 2. Adopting Final Millage Rate. The final millage rate to be levied for the Town of Surfside for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2018 and ending September 30, 2019 is hereby fixed at 4.5000 mills per \$1,000.00 of assessed property value.

 **Section 3. Announcing Percentage Decrease.** The proposed millage rate of 4.5000 mills is less than the rolled-back rate of ~~4.8463~~ 4.8090 mills computed pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, by ~~7.15~~ 6.43%.

Note: Section 3 of this Resolution was amended after adoption to correct a scrivener’s error in the rolled-back rate and percentage by which the final millage rate is less than the rolled-back rate. Additions to text are shown in underline. Deletions to text are shown in ~~strikethrough~~.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.




