## **ORDINANCE NO. 2024-<u>1776</u>**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 70-122, OF DIVISION 1.—"RESORT TAX", OF ARTICLE IV.—"RESORT TAX", CHAPTER 70 OF THE TOWN CODE, TO AMEND THE TAXES TO CONSTITUTE SPECIAL FUND; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

1	WHEREAS, the Town of Sunside (the "Town") has a Resort Tax (the "Tax") to
2	explore, create, and organize events and activities that enhance Town tourism; and
3	WHEREAS, Section 70-122 of the Town Code establishes a separate fund for the
4	Tax; and
5	WHEREAS, the Town Commission desires to delete any required minimum
6	allocation of the Tax directed to advertising, promotion and special events; and
7	WHEREAS, in order to achieve the Town's objectives, the Town Commission
8	seeks to amend Section 70-122 to delete any specific allocation directed to particular
9	activities; and
10	WHEREAS, the Town Commission finds that amending Section 70-122 of the
11	Town Code is in the best interest and welfare of the Town.
12 13 14 15 16	NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE HEREBY ORDAINS:  Section 1. Recitals Adopted. The above-stated recitals are hereby adopted.

20 21	Surfside, Florida is hereby amended by amending Section 70-122, "Taxes to constitute special fund", as follows:

37	The total receipts of the resort tax portion from the tax imposed and levied pursuant
38	to this article shall be kept and maintained in a separate fund and shall in no event be
39	transferred to the general fund. The use of this fund is subject to the budgetary
40	process of the town on a fiscal year basis. A budget for the utilization of this fund must
41	be submitted for the town commission approval as a part of the budget adoption
42	process. A minimum of 34 percent of the fund shall be used for the promotion of the
43	tourist industry under the annual tourist bureau budget, which shall include but not be
44	restricted to the following: publicity, advertising, promotional events, tourist bureau

48 49	Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this
49 50	ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction,
50 51	then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this
52	ordinance.

54	Section 4. Inclusion in the Code. It is the intention of the Town
55	Commission, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become
56	and made a part of the Town of Surfside Code of Ordinances, that the sections of this
57	Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intentions; and the word
58	"Ordinance" may be changed to "Section" or other appropriate word.

60	Section 5. Conflicts. Any and all Ordinances and Resolutions or parts of
61	Ordinances or Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

63	<b>Section 6. Effective Date.</b> That this Ordinance shall become effective upon
64	adoption.
