Summary of Noteworthy Calls for Service

03/25/2025	Arrest	1200 Block of Biscaya Drive

Units responded to a report of a male observed in the backyard of an unoccupied residence. Upon arrival, the male was gone on arrival (GOA). Officers observed a scooter parked on the side of the unoccupied residence and conducted a canvass of the area with negative results.

Subsequently, officers maintained a stealth position near the bridge. A short time later, a male was observed traveling with the scooter previously seen on the side of the house. After being advised of his Miranda rights, the male was unable to dispel the officers' concerns. He was then arrested and transported to TGK.

03/26/2025 Burglary 8830 Garland Ave

The victim reported that her vehicle was burglarized between March 25, 2025, at 1800 hours and March 26, 2025, at 1105 hours. The vehicle had been left unlocked, but no items were reported missing.

An area canvass was conducted, but no CCTV footage was found. The Criminal Investigations Unit was notified. Miami Beach Police Department Crime Scene responded to the scene and processed the vehicle. A report was written and forwarded to CIU.

03/21/2025 Bench Warrant Arrest 4 Season's Hotel

Officers responded to a report of a Black female seen on camera inside the hotel without authorization, attempting to open guest room doors. When approached by security, she left the hotel. Officers made contact with the female outside the hotel, and a records check revealed an active warrant out of Tennessee. She was arrested and transported to TGK.

03/28/2025 Assault 9400 Harding Ave

The victim, an elderly male, reported being involved in an altercation with an adult male while waiting at a bus stop. The dispute escalated when the male suspect punched the victim in the head, threatened him with a knife, and then fled northbound on Harding Avenue.

The victim had no visible injuries but complained of head pain. Miami-Dade Fire Rescue responded, treated him on scene, and released him. A BOLO was broadcast, and officers conducted an area search. A male matching the suspect's description was detained, and a show-up was conducted with the victim. However, the victim was unable to make a positive identification. The Criminal Investigations Unit (CIU) was contacted and responded to the scene.
