04/18/2025	Assisting an Officer	9800 Block of Harding
<p>An SPD officer was flagged down by an anonymous complainant who expressed concern about a male who appeared to be asleep at the wheel of a vehicle. The officer located the vehicle and observed an adult male seemingly asleep in the driver's seat. While waiting for backup, the male woke up and began to drive away. The officer initiated a traffic stop and successfully brought the vehicle to a stop approximately half a block from the original location. The driver was detained without incident until units from Bal Harbour PD arrived on scene and assumed control.</p>

<p>Officers responded to a call for service regarding a male whom store management wanted trespassed. Upon arrival, store security reported that the male had been acting erratically and consuming alcohol on the property. Contact was made with the individual, who was seated in the store's outdoor seating area and appeared calm. A records check revealed an extensive criminal history but no active wants or warrants. The male was formally trespassed by management in the presence of officers and left the area on his bicycle.</p>		

04/20/2025	Deceased Person	8900/9100 Block of Beach
<p>Units responded to a swimmer in distress. The individual was located and rescued by Miami-Dade Fire Rescue. Miami-Dade Fire Rescue then transported the person to Mount Sinai Hospital in Miami Beach, where they were pronounced deceased. The Miami-Dade Sheriff's Office was contacted and responded to the scene.</p>
