The purpose of this Letter to Commission (LTC) is to inform you of the following Construction Activities in Town, being performed by FDOT, as outlined below.

There may be times where one side street at a time is continuously closed during the work. We apologize for the inconvenience. Crews will work to reopen lanes as quickly as possible. One southbound lane may be closed along Harding Avenue between 96 Street and 69 Street between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. The side streets from 93 Street to 88 Street between Harding Avenue and Abbott Avenue will be intermittently closed during drainage work Please note on-street parking will be temporarily eliminated where active work is taking place. PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS SCHEDULE MAY CHANGE DUE TO WEATHER OR UNEXPECTED CON-DITIONS.
