Subject: Third Annual Remembrance Event

Please join us as we honor the 98 souls lost along with all those impacted by the devastating June 24, 2021 building collapse. A lighting of the torch ceremony will be held at 1:22 a.m. at Veteran's Park followed by the 10 a.m. daytime event on 88th Street, the future site of the Surfside Memorial.

The daytime event will include seating for up to 250 attendees. The location of the event was coordinated with the Surfside Memorial Committee members and it is close to the building site. The Town received outside funding only for the First Year Remembrance Event. The Second Year Remembrance event was funded by the Town. The Third Year Remembrance Event will also be funded by the Town. See Exhibit "A" for the probable cost estimate for this year's event.
