### **MEDIA AREA**

A designated media area will be available for press located east of the main tent. A pool feed will be set up and available for the press.

Media with cameras/equipment are not allowed inside the main tent and must remain within the designated area, no exceptions.

### **SET UP & PARKING**

Media parking is located on the west side of Collins Avenue north of 88th Street. Please use the parallel parking spaces.

Please set up your equipment in the media tent before 9:30 a.m. The remaining walkway will be congested making access difficult for set up after that time.

### **MEMORIAL FLYOVER**

A Memorial Flyover by Miami-Dade Police Aviation will take place at 9:45 a.m. prior to the beginning of the 10 a.m. ceremony along with a special display on the 200 block of 88th Street adjacent to the Surfside Tennis Center/Veteran's Park.

### **1:22 AM TORCH LIGHTING**

The Town will be holding a lighting of the torch ceremony at 1:22 a.m. alongside Miami-Dade Fire Rescue (MDFR) and first responders/law enforcement.

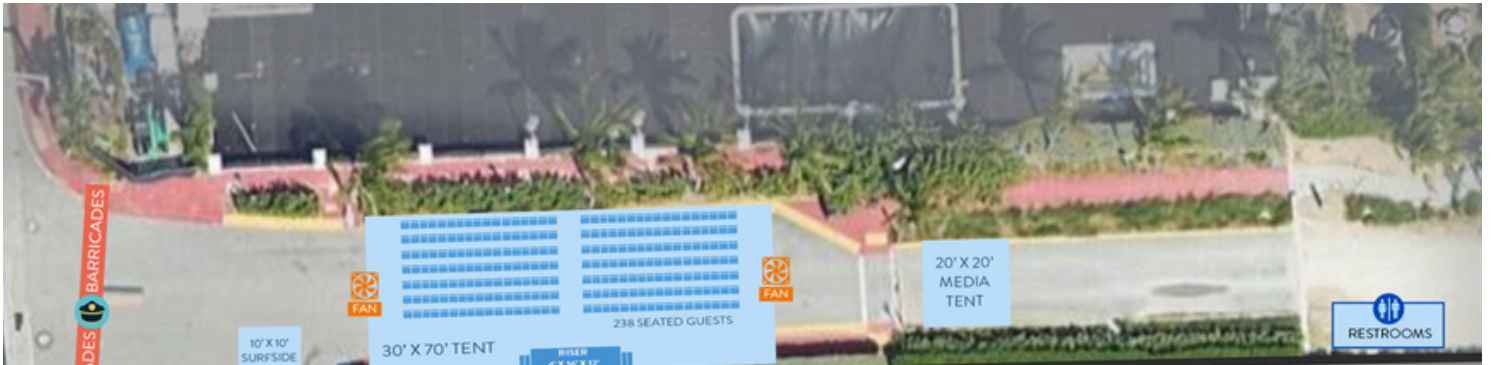
